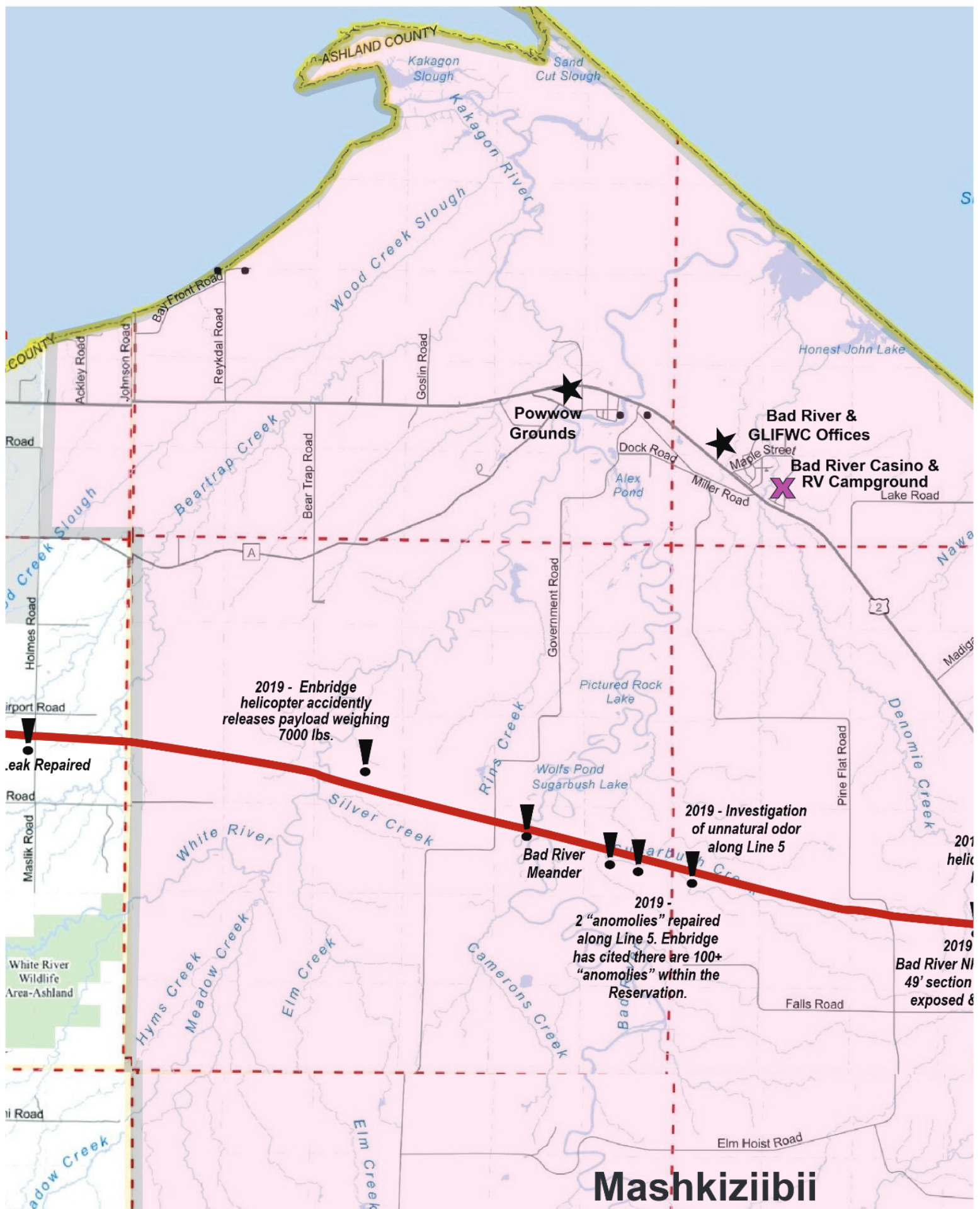

CAMPING

GLIFWC Camping Permits

GLIFWC has a permit process for people with treaty rights in the 1837/1842 treaty areas to camp at US Forest Service campgrounds for free. These permits also allow people to camp for longer than the normal campground regulations. It may also allow people to camp in dispersed areas longer than 21 days.

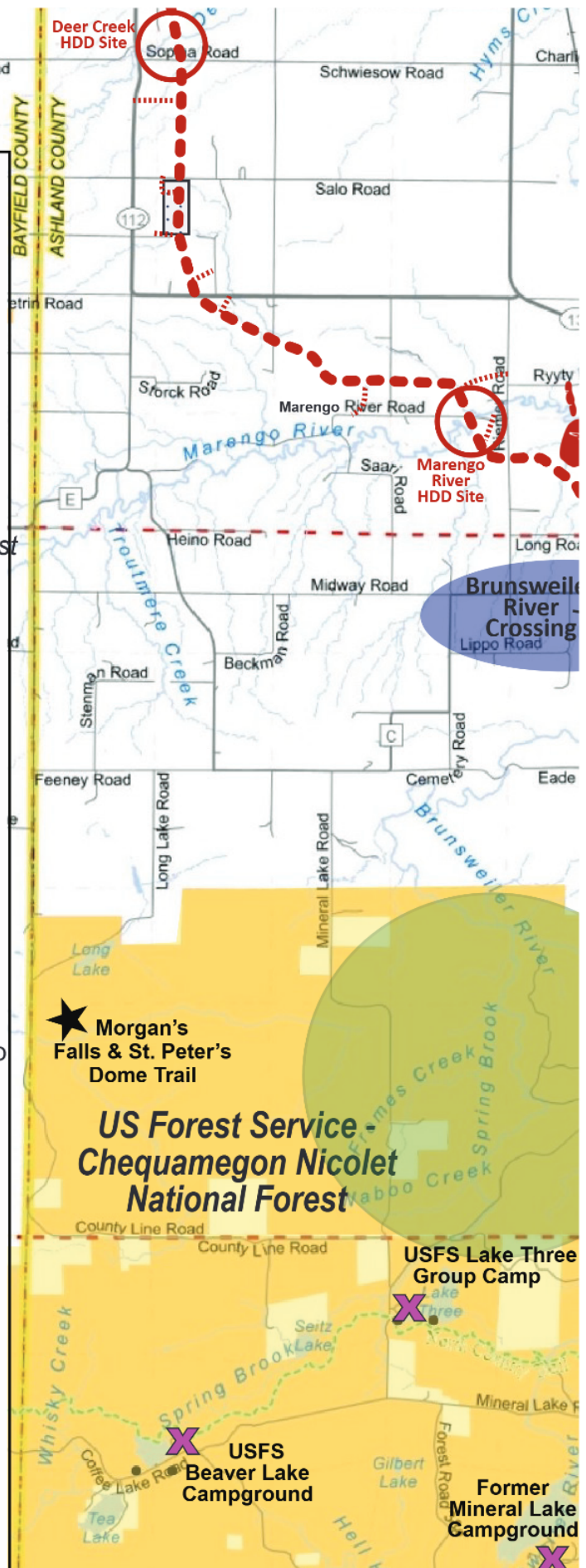

Dispersed Camping

- **USFS Chequamegon Nicolet National Forest (CNNF)** - There is free dispersed camping allowed within the CNNF. Occupancy is limited to 21 days at the same site within a 30 day period, 1 mile away from previous site.
- **County Forests** - There is free, dispersed camping allowed within Ashland, Bayfield, and Iron forest lands. Occupancy of the same site is limited to 14 days.

Other Camping Options

- **USFS Beaver Lake Campground** - \$15/day
- **USFS Lake Three** - There may be an informal group site for dispersed camping here
- **USFS Mineral Lake Campground** - Permanently closed; may be able to dispersed camp here
- **Copper Falls State Park (Mellen)** - \$25/night
- **Potato River Falls Campground (Gurney)** - \$10/night, 2 week limit
- **Upson Falls Campground** - \$10/night, 7 day limit
- **Prentice Park Camping (Ashland)** - \$30/night
- **Kreher Park RV Camping (Ashland)** - \$55/night
- **Thompson's West End** - \$40/night
- **Weber Lake Campground (Upson)** \$32/night
- **Highbridge Hills Campground & Disk Golf (Highbridge)** \$40/person/night
- **Saxon Harbor Campground (Saxon)** \$30/night
- **Wildhaven Campground & Resort (Mellen)** - \$30/nt
