CAMPING

GLIFWC Camping Permits

GLIFWC has a permit process for people with treaty rights in the 1837/1842 treaty areas to camp at US Forest Service campgrounds for free. These permits also allow people to stay at campsites for longer than the normal regulations and allows camping in dispersed areas longer than 21 days.

Dispersed Camping

- Dispersed camping is camping on public lands not within a designated campground. Check each entity for additional regulations.
- USFS Chequamegon Nicolet National Forest (CNNF): There is free dispersed camping allowed within the CNNF. Occupancy is limited to 21 days at the same site within a 30 day period, 1 mile away from previous site.
- County Forests - There is free, dispersed camping allowed within Ashland, Bayfield, and Iron forest lands. Occupancy of the same site is limited to 14 days.

- Kreher Park RV Camping (Ashland) - \$55/nt
- Prentice Park Camping (Ashland) - \$30/nt
- Thompson's West End (Washburn) - \$40/nt

Bad River & Saxon Area

- Bad River Casino RV Campground - \$10/nt, 2 week limit
- Saxon Harbor Campground (Saxon) - \$30/nt

Mellen Area

- USFS Beaver Lake Campground - \$15/nt
- Copper Falls State Park (Mellen) - \$25/nt
- Upson Falls Campground - \$10/night, 7 day limit
- Highbridge Hills Campground - \$40/person/nt
- Weber Lake Campground (Upson) - \$32/night
- Wildhaven Campground & Resort (Mellen) - \$30/nt

Bad River Reservation

Roughly half of the lands within the Bad River Reservation are "non-tribal" and owned by non-tribal members as private fee lands, county/state/federal entities, and other non-tribally owned entities. Our efforts to protect the water are aligned with decolonization and land back.

2019 - Enbridge helicopter accidentally releases payload weighing 7000 lbs.

2019 - 2 "anomalies" repaired along Line 5. Enbridge has cited there are 100+ "anomalies" within the Reservation.

July - Aug 1996
Bad River members blockade railroad to prevent train carrying sulfuric acid for mining to cross the Bad River

2019 - Slope 18
Bad River NRD staff discover 49' section of Line 5 found exposed & unsupported.

2019 - Investigation of unnatural odor along Line 5

2018 - Enbridge helicopter crashes killing pilot
